

Departing from Brussels Airport, there are 2 ways to get to the ITM

BY BUS (in the airport, follow the blue signs indicating a bus)

Each hour, exactly on the hour, there leaves a shuttlebus (Airport Express from the company: De Decker Van Riet) to the 'Antwerp Central' train station. In high season (from 1/4 to 30/9) there is a bus every hour except at 2am and at 3am, including Sundays and Public Holidays. In low season (from 1/10 to 31/3) the first bus leaves at 5am, the last bus at 12pm. Important: in low season, the 5 and 6am busses do not ride on Sundays and Public Holidays). The price for this ticket is 10 euro's. You can buy your ticket in the bus. The ride will take between 40-60 minutes depending on traffic. BY TRAIN (in the airport, follow the blue signs indicating a train)

Underneath the airport, there is a train station. You can there take a direct train to the 'Antwerp Central' train station. The price for the ticket will be 11,20 euro's and you have to buy it in advance at the ticket office. Please check the following link for the exact hours: <http://www.b-rail.be/main/E/>

Name of station of departure: Brussels Airport

Name of station of arrival: Antwerp Central

The ride will take between 35-45 minutes depending on the stops (an IC-train has fewer stops than an L-train)

If you are at the Antwerp Central Station you can take public transport or a cab to the ITM or your hotel.
